



The Kingfisher School

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you that the uniform policy has been updated to include the change of colour of the school jumper/cardigan. This information was shared with you by the School Learning Council earlier in the year. The policy has now been approved by the Local Governing Body and can be found on The Kingfisher School website. If you require a paper copy please contact the school office.

In summary, from September, the following uniform rules will apply:

- Grey jumper or cardigan with the school logo – available from the Initially Yours website http://www.initiallyyours.co.uk/schools/kingfisher_school/school_uniform.htm (Your summer 2017 order will be sent directly to The Kingfisher School – all orders placed by you from September will be sent to your chosen delivery address.
 - Plain white polo shirt – available from local supermarkets or other clothing retailers;
 - Plain white blouse for girls or white shirt for boys;
 - Black school trousers for boys and girls – not joggers or leggings;
 - Black skirts or pinafore dresses for the girls
 - Purple check dresses for the girls – available from local supermarkets or other clothing retailers
 - Flat, sensible black shoes suitable for active play. No trainers, daps or casual style shoes with coloured style flashes (see Appendix 1 for images of suitable and unsuitable shoes). No boots, including ankle boots;
 - Plain white, grey or black socks and tights;
 - Plain purple, black or grey hijab.

There must be no embellishment of the school uniform e.g. piping, ribbon, sequins etc.

PE Uniform:

- Black shorts and black jogging bottoms, white T shirt and black/navy sweatshirt
- Daps/plimsolls – not branded trainers
- Swimming costume – where applicable

For health and safety reasons, it is essential that children are dressed appropriately for any physical activity. Appropriate footwear is essential: trainers or plimsolls should be worn or bare feet for gymnastics and dance only. All items of PE clothing should be identified with the child's name. Children who go swimming need a towel, swimming trunks / shorts or one-piece costume, carried in a waterproof bag.

Outdoor clothing

Smart, showerproof, jacket-style coats and **must be named**.

Parents must label all items of clothing clearly with their child's name.

Jewellery, hair accessories and Fashion Items

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. The exceptions to this rule are earring studs in pierced ears. We expect the children to remove them during PE and Games or parents to provide tape. Hair accessories are to be functional and not a fashion item e.g. 'Jo-Jo bows'. Accessories such as make-up, nail polish, false nails and jewellery other than stud earrings must not be worn. Tattoos are not permitted.

Hair

The school does not permit children to have haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. Long hair on both girls and boys should be tied back neatly. Extreme hairstyles or colours are not permitted.

Non-Compliance with the School Uniform Policy

When joining our school, you will be required to sign our Home-School Agreement, which identifies that parents will ensure your child wears the correct uniform to school.

Children that are chosen by their peers to represent them on the School Learning Council are expected to wear uniform at all times and if they do not, they risk losing their position.
