



Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been great to see so many smiling faces in our live lessons this week. Thank you for all your contributions so far and for your patience as we all adapt to this new way of working.

As we move into the second week of our live lessons, I wanted to inform you that as of next week, all children who are learning remotely from home, will be able to access two live lessons per day. This will include either a Phonics or Reading lesson, and an Author lesson.

To ensure that families where siblings are sharing a device are able to access all the appropriate sessions, we have had to make some slight changes to the timetable that we sent out last week.

Please find the new timetable below. This timetable is effective from **Monday 25th January 2021** but please note the Author lessons will not begin until **Tuesday 26th January 2021** and will run until further notice.

12:30pm – 1:15pm	Yew Class (Years 2 and 3) Author Lesson
1:30pm – 2:00pm	Willow Class (Reception and Year 1) Author Lesson
2:00pm – 2:30pm	Cherry Tree Class (Years 4, 5 and 6) Reading lesson.

The Author and Reading slides and resources will continue to be made available for children to access on Google Classroom.

From time to time, the teacher may want to contact you in advance of the lesson in case there is anything your child may need to do before hand. If this is the case, the class teacher will contact you **before 4pm** on the previous day using Microsoft Teams.
