<p>Dear Parents/Carers,</p> <p>This term our enquiry question is ‘Where do our fruit and vegetables come from?’ The question is based on the children’s interest in where their snack time fruits come from.</p> <p>We will be planting seeds and cooking with fruit and vegetables and linking this theme with popular stories.</p> <p>Our class story this term is the traditional story, The Enormous Turnip. We will be concentrating on setting up the role play as a fruit and veg shop and introducing a variety of fruit and vegetables into role play.</p> <p>During the term, we are going to ask our school cook to come and talk to the children about how she cooks fruit and vegetables and also how food arrives at the school kitchen.</p> 	<p>Literacy activities this term will focus around our story with story mapping and sequencing the story.</p> <p>We will continue teaching about rhythm and rhyme and alliteration. Children will learn to recognise and write their first names through letters and sounds.</p> <p>Maths this term will focus on shape and measures. Children will have lots of opportunities to weigh and measure fruit and vegetables as well as count them!</p>
