This week the children will be learning to:

- Talk about their journey to school and where they live using maps (Google).
- Learn the letter sound (phoneme) for letter i. The character for this letter is an insect. The rhyme for the formation of this letter is 'Down his body and dot for his head'. It would be great if you could bring in something beginning with i for our sound box!
- Celebrate Chinese New Year by learning a 'Dragon Dance'. We will be doing this activity with the children in Oak Class (Reception).

Our rhyme of the week is a short poem to link with the snow we have experienced over the weekend called 'It's snowing, it's blowing.'
