This week the children will be learning to:

- Observe change over time as they see the cress seeds that we planted last week growing. We are hoping to taste the cress at snack time during the week!
- Learn the letter sound (phoneme) for letter o. The character for this letter is an orange. The rhyme for the formation of this letter is 'All around the orange.' It would be great if you could bring in something beginning with o for our sound box!
- Use their creative skills as they paint the fruit they made from clay in PEEP group.

On Thursday we have two exciting activities:

We have been invited to a tea party in Oak Class to celebrate the story 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'.

Later in the morning, we also have a fantastic opportunity to observe birds of prey.

Our rhyme of the week is 'Hey, Diddle, Diddle...'
