Dear Parents and Carers,

This week the children will be learning to:

- Re-tell the 'Handa's Hen' story through actions.
- Learn the letter sounds (phonemes) for letters r and h. The character for r is a robot and the character for h is a horse.

The rhymes for the formation of these letters are:

r – down his back and curl over his arm.

h – down the horses neck to his hooves and over his back.

Please remember to look at your child's learning diary on line and add observations of your own. We would love to know what the children have been learning at home. If you do not have access to your child's diary at home, please ask to use one of our school I pads. You could add your observations during PEEP group time.
